Dear Parent/Carer,

This term, we are excited to be launching the **St Bernard's Award** with our Year 9 students.

This Award is aimed at rewarding the many talents our students have, ensuring they grow to be rounded individuals who make the most of their God-given gifts.

To achieve the Award, students will have to demonstrate that they have engaged successfully in a range of development activities each term, for example, a physical activity, a skill, and doing something to serve and give back to their community. There are many more categories they must show evidence for which can be found in their Award booklet. If they complete these tasks each term, they will be eligible for the St Bernard's Award, and subsequent reward activities, in July.

Every child is unique and has different strengths and talents. We feel we should recognise these and instil in students that achievement and success can be demonstrated in a wide array of ways. It is hoped this will also benefit student's mental well-being and pastoral development as they develop internal-personal skills required for future success.


