UNIFORM

Uniform at St. Bernard's contributes to our culture and ethos of equality and high expectations for all, promoting a sense of school identity, belonging and pride.

We have preloved uniform for sale at a reduced cost and we work with Pinders and Johnny D who are always happy to help you!

You must be in correct uniform during the school day. This includes wearing your jumper in the corridors and only removing the jumper with permission in class. Shirts must be tucked in and skirts must be knee length (not rolled).

- First incident: O point log; uniform provided
- Repeated incidents: C3 logged (detention); FT to contact home.
- Refusal to comply: Reflection in St. Monica's/with Head of House.
- False eyelashes, nail varnish/nails: Must be removed by the next day or procedure
- Piercings: Must be removed immediately (one ear stud per ear allowed).


